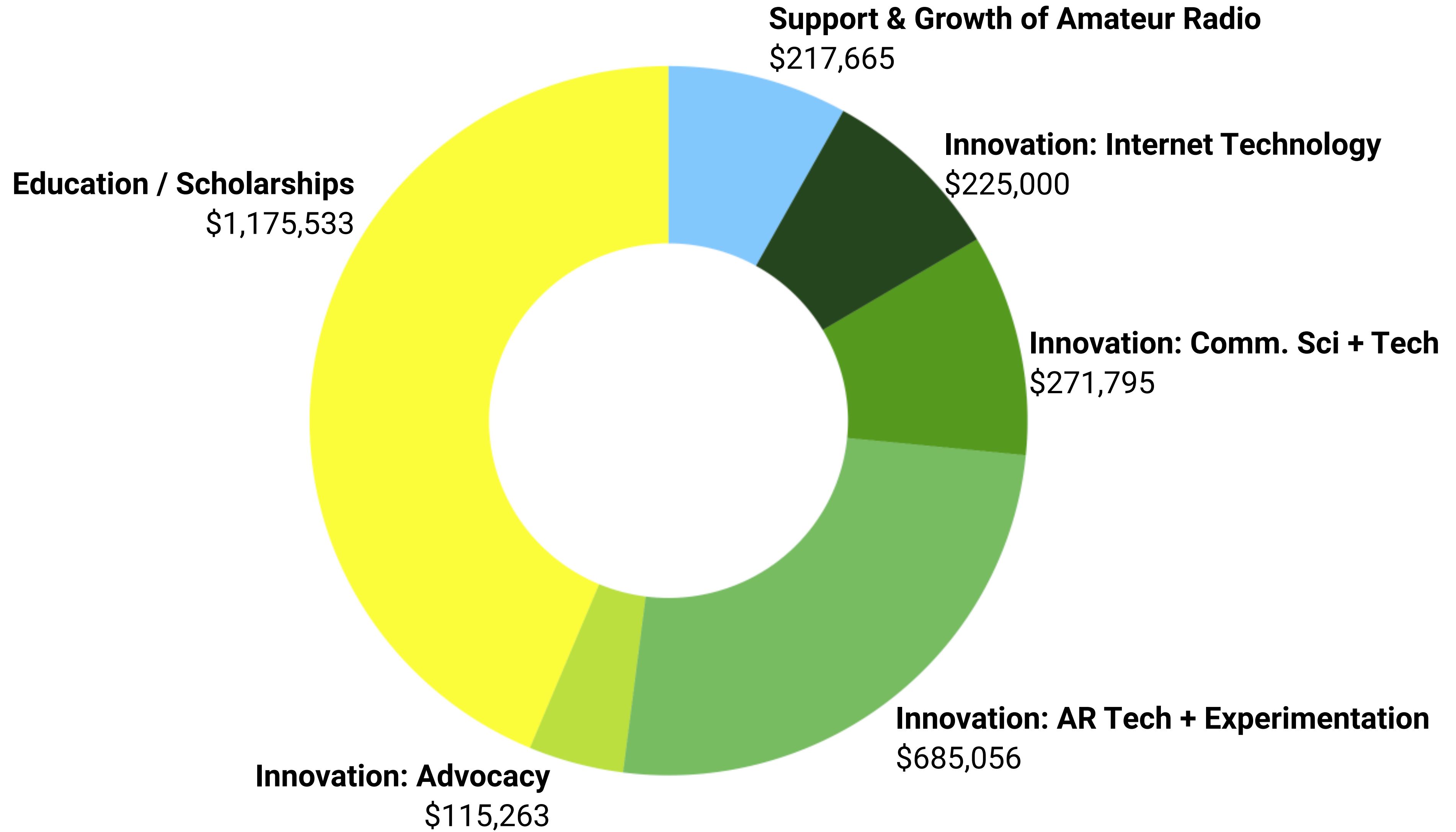

  - Hired first Executive Director to follow founder Brian Kantor
  - Invested proceeds of address space sale

# 44net – Goals

- Rebuild Portal back-end and administrative frameworks (in-progress)
- With guidance of the TAC, prioritize known issues and develop plans (incl. budgets) for:
  - How to make Portal easier to use
    - For existing 44net users
    - For new users
  - Improving documentation for using the Portal
  - Strategy for IPv4 & IPv6
  - Better routing
